

SPECIAL SESSION OF THE VILLAGE BOARD OF TRUTEES ON OCTOBER 4, 2021
AT VILLAGE HALL 61 FRONT ST 5:30 PM.

PRESENT: Mayor Moore, Trustees, Durning, Price and Warner, Clerk Treasurer Budine, Deputy Clerk Treasurer Bev Shirkey, Supervisor Steve Evans and Bridget Davis.

ABSENT: Trustees Brown.

Mayor Moore called the meeting to order to discuss pending litigation.

MOTION#174 /21-22

A motion was made by Trustee Price and seconded by Trustee Warner to go in to Executive Session to discuss pending litigation. Motion passed unanimously

MOTION#175 /21-22

A motion was made by Trustee Durning and seconded by Trustee Price to come out of Executive Session. Motion passed unanimously.

Mayor Moore called the Special meeting to order at 6:00PM and welcomed Mark and Jeanne Tucker, Vicki and Pete Hempstead, Colleen Zuhone and Village Counsel Mike Livolsi who was in attendance via Zoom.

Mayor Moore invited Ms. Tucker to address the board. Ms. Tucker read from a prepared speech. Ms. Tucker formally requested that the Village of Deposit share the costs of potential damage to her parents building next to the A-Z. Mayor Moore stated that the wall belongs to the A-Z building, owned by the Village and it is not a shared wall. Ms. Tucker said that she had heard there was Federal or State money to pay for the demolition. Mayor Moore stated that it wasn't for demolition but would help cover the cost of the tipping fees for dumping of the debris. Mayor Moore stated there would be a meeting with Gorrick tomorrow at 8:30AM and invited the Hempstead's and Tucker's to attend. Mr. Moore stated that we won't know anything about the demolition situation until Thursday, and no decisions could be made before that. Ms. Tucker asked about being included in the demolition companies insurance and she was advised to ask Gorrick if that was possible, when they attend the meeting tomorrow morning. Mayor Moore thanked everyone for attending.

MOTION#176 /21-22

A motion was made by Trustee Price and seconded by Trustee Warner to go in to Executive Session to discuss pending litigation. Motion passed unanimously

MOTION#177 /21-22

A motion was made by Trustee Price and seconded by Trustee Durning to come out of Executive Session. Motion passed unanimously.

Mayor Moore stated that the Village cannot afford all these costs and if the Village has to borrow money to pay for this he won't burden the taxpayers with interest on borrowed money but instead will visit the EDRLF committee to cover the costs of the demolition and construction of the Hempstead's wall.

MOTION#178/20-21

A motion was made by Trustee Price and seconded by Trustee Durning to adjourn at 7:05 PM. Motion passed unanimously.
