

Guidelines and Agreements

Deposit, NY Community Garden



With support from the Village of Deposit, NY and Cornell Cooperative Extension we are creating a place for residents to learn, grow and enjoy their own garden spaces. Healthy food and flowers will fill the beds next to the Village Hall

(61 Front St, Deposit, NY 13754)

Once my application is approved:

1. I will attend a mandatory orientation as a member of the Deposit, NY Community Garden. If I cannot attend the date I will contact a Deposit Community Garden Committee member and set up a make up date for the orientation.
2. I will obtain my own seeds or plants for my garden bed.
3. I will plant my assigned garden bed within a week of my application being approved. (Weather pending!)
4. I will keep my garden bed & surrounding pathways clear of litter, trash and tools.
5. I will keep my garden bed weeded throughout the garden season. If my plot becomes overgrown I will be contacted by a Deposit Community Garden Committee member and given a deadline to cleanup. If I fail to maintain my garden plot, I will be notified that within 15 days and the plot will be reassigned to a new member.
6. If I must abandon my garden bed, I will contact a Deposit Community Garden Committee member immediately.
7. I will not pick crops from other members garden beds, unless given permission by them.
8. I will not use any chemical pesticides, fungicides, rodenticides or weed killers on my garden bed or anywhere else in the garden.
9. I will not bring pets or any other animals to the garden.
10. The Deposit Community Garden is not responsible for lost/stolen items in or around my garden bed.
11. Deposit Community Garden members cannot use the garden space for personal social activities, political campaigns or the promotion of any private or religious organization.
